
What does toggling off linked selection in the Timeline do?

It allows you to select and trim one track of a linked clip.

What does the Ripple tool do when you use it for trimming?

It ripples the trim amount through the unlocked tracks in the sequence.

What is the keyboard shortcut to select the Ripple tool?

Pressing R R selects the Ripple tool.

What keys can you use as shortcuts to ripple a clip's edit point by a few frames?

use the left and right bracket keys ([and]) and the < and > (angle bracket) keys.

What is one advantage of trimming a clip in the Viewer?

You can view the material outside the marked area.

How can you disable a single clip in the sequence?

Control-click the clip in the sequence and toggle off Clip Enable in the shortcut menu.

What tools can you use to drag an edit point in the Timeline?

Use the default Selection tool and the Ripple tool.

What is the keyboard shortcut for extending an edit?

The E key extends an edit.

What tracks does the Razor Blade tool cut when you click a clip?

It cuts through all the tracks of a linked clip when linked selection is on.

How do you drag a clip vertically in the Timeline without moving it horizontally?

Hold down the Shift key as you drag.

What is the advantage of editing on the V2 track?

It allows you to lengthen a clip without bumping into a bordering clip on either side.

Keyboard: B

Selects the Razor Blade tool

Keyboard: BB

Selects the Razor Blade All
tool

Keyboard: E

Extends an edit

Keyboard: N

Toggles snapping off and
on

Keyboard: RR

Selects the Ripple tool

Keyboard: Option-
Command-W

Toggles audio waveforms
off and on in the Timeline

Keyboard: Shift-L

Toggles linked selection
off and on
