From what menu do you select Speed?

From the Modify menu.

---

How can you tell if the speed of a sequence clip has been changed?

A speed percentage will appear next to the sequence clip name.

---

What type of edit can change clip speed automatically as you edit into the Timeline?

A fit to fill edit.

---

When you create a freeze frame, does a new freeze frame clip appear in the Browser automatically?

No, but you can drag the freeze frame image from the Viewer to the Browser if you like.

---

Where do you access motion parameters?

In the Motion tab.

How can you change motion parameters directly in the Canvas?

Choose Image+Wireframe from the Canvas View popup menu.

How can motion attributes be copied and pasted?

Copy the clip and access the Paste Attributes window.

Where are motion keyframes set and adjusted?

In the Motion tab keyframe graph area.

What is a motion path?

The path a clip moves along between two or more keyframes.

What tool do you use to hide unnecessary portions of an image?

The Crop tool.

How is rotation measured in the Motion tab?

In degrees.

Keyboard: C

Selects the Crop tool

Keyboard: Command-J

Opens the Speed dialog

Keyboard: Shift-K

Moves forward to next  
keyframe

Keyboard: Option-K

Moves backward to  
previous keyframe

Keyboard: Shift-N

Creates freeze frame from  
playhead position

Keyboard: W

Toggles among Image, Image+Wireframe, and Wireframe modes.

Keyboard: Option-8

Opens the QuickView tool

Keyboard: Shift-F5

Locks or unlocks all audio tracks in a sequence.
